# A GUIDE FOR LENT 2025

## DEVOTIONAL

We will be reading through a Lent devotional titled, "From Wilderness to Glory: Lent and Easter for Everyone" written by N.T. Wright. Each day there is a devotional passage with reflective questions at the end of each day. Please take 15-20 minutes everyday to read through the material, pray, and let the thoughts sink in. There is no reading for Sundays throughout the 40 days to pause and celebrate the Easter season.

## DISCIPLINE OF FASTING

Take some time to think about one thing (i.e. social media; food; entertainment; indulgences; etc.) to abstain from during the 40 days of Lent. It will be difficult and a journey, but we hope that as you fast, your desperation and intimacy for and with the Lord will grow. You can rest from your fast every Sunday to pause and celebrate the Easter season.

## DISCIPLINE OF PRAYER IN COMMUNITY

As a church community and family, we will commit to praying for EIKON every Monday at 6:00am. Please make an effort to pray at that time in the comfort of your own home or workplace. Also, use the time to do the daily devotional.

The items of prayer for the season of Lent are as follows:

*Monday March 10*

Pray for the EIKON Staff, Board, & Tapestry Leaders to stay close with Jesus and lean into Him in every circumstance.

*Monday March 17*

Pray for those in EIKON who are struggling with physical and/or mental illness to find healing not only from their illness, but to have a deeper understanding that God is with them.

*Monday March 24*

*Pray for the young adults (20s and 30s) of EIKON to stand firm in their identity in Christ and to be a resilient generation that has a passion for His kingdom.*

*Monday March 31*

Pray for the families with children to raise households of faith and make Christ central to their homes.

*Monday April 7*

Pray for those in EIKON who may be wrestling with their faith and have entered seasons of doubt and dryness, to hold on and for the Spirit to bring restoration and refreshment.

*Monday April 14 (Passion Week)*

Pray for EIKON Church to be a community committed to fully knowing and accepting Christ's love and for it to compel us to love others around us.
